



# AIRBRUSH ART EXHIBITION

24th & 25th July 2010

## INFORMATION FORM

Airbrush artists from all over Australia are encouraged to present their best work of art at MotorEx, Sydney Showground, July 24 & 25, 2010.

Entries to the MotorEx Iwata Airbrush Art Exhibition will be accepted on almost any media. These may include:

**Automotive related articles** – it is all about the celebration of modified and customised cars expressing an owners attitude to individuality. Each piece for consideration must be created on an automotive related item e.g. a bonnet, door skin, boot lid, tonneau cover, hubcap, bumper bar, motorcycle tank or guard - in other words, any piece of as vehicle but not a whole car or vehicle.

**Alternative** - a class where artists can show other forms of airbrush artistic expression such as but not limited to clothing, solid surfaces (portraits), helmets, surfboards – in fact anything that can be simply displayed in the exhibition, the only restriction is size.

For the first time at MotorEx the viewing public will be able to vote for their favourite piece of art. The winning piece will receive vouchers to the value of \$350.00. These vouchers will be able to be used toward the purchase of any product from the Anest Iwata range. There will be nomination forms and a collection barrel provided – sponsors, artists and their families are prohibited from voting.

### How to enter

Artists should advise Anest Iwata of their intention to display artwork by 1<sup>st</sup> July 2010 by completing the attached entry form. Participants must complete one entry form for each article and forward it to Anest Iwata by fax to 02 9853 2090. Entries may be accepted on the day of set up of the event ( Friday July 23 ), subject to available display space. Transport of display pieces to and from the exhibition is the responsibility of the artist.

### Displaying

All pieces must be hung ready for public viewing and judging by 9pm Friday July 23 2010. Displaying artists may identify themselves by name and contact phone number, including business details. To maintain fairness signs displaying such details can be no bigger than 20cm square. Representatives of the sponsors, Anest Iwata will be on site to provide assistance in the placement of your artwork.

Details regarding delivery and set up times will be made available to all registered participants during June.

### Sale or removal of Artwork

Artists may sell their displayed items. No article is to removed before 6pm Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> January 2010.
