

PRIVACY STATEMENT

ANEST IWATA Australia (AI-AU) respects your privacy. This Privacy Statement informs you of our privacy practices.

Privacy

Your privacy is taken seriously by AI-AU. You can generally browse our website without providing any personal information. Should you decide to contact us for further information on our products via our website, we make every effort to prevent unauthorised access to any information given. We do not store your details gathered from the Web Site or enter them onto any lists and use details given only to answer that particular query and deal with any ensuing correspondence, the only exception being when you subscribe to our e-newsletter or are enrolling in a course, in which case we will need to keep your information recorded for future use. You are always able to opt out of receiving our e-newsletter.

AI-AU will not sell, rent or lease your personal information to others. AI-AU does share personal information with companies working on our behalf and AI-AU associated business entities.

Except as described in this Statement, AI-AU will not share the personal information you provide to AI-AU with any third parties without your permission, unless to: (i) respond to duly authorized information requests of governmental authorities; (ii) comply with any law, regulation, subpoena, or court order; (iii) help prevent fraud or to enforce or protect the rights and properties of AI-AU or its subsidiaries; or (iv) protect the personal safety of AI-AU employees and third parties on AI-AU property.

Collection of personal information

We may ask you to provide personal information. For example, when you subscribe to our e-newsletter we will ask you to provide personal information to complete this task.

In addition to the information you provide, AI-AU **may** also collect information during your visit to the AI-AU website through Automatic Data Collection Tools, which include Web beacons, cookies, embedded Web links and other commonly used information-gathering tools.
